## Instructions to Authors

The Bulletin is typeset using LaTeX; therefore, authors should submit articles to the Bulletin as LaTeX input files together with any macro files or input files for the production of graphics. Typescripts are **not** acceptable. Source files should be suitable for processing using **pdflatex**. All files should be accompanied by any non-standard style or input files which have been used. Private METAFONT and TEX macros, reference input files and files for diagrams must also accompany submissions. The preferred method of submission is by e-mail to

Only if this is not possible, authors may send a CD with their files to the Editor together with a printout of the typescript. If articles are submitted in electronic form, no hard copies need to be sent unless requested by the Editor. Once a paper is accepted in final form, the author(s) will be responsible for producing an output according to the Bulletin's standard layout. To this end, authors will be supplied with style files. Since normally no proofs are sent out before publication, it is the author's responsibility to check carefully for any misprints or typos. After publication, authors will be sent a free copy of the issue in which their article(s) appeared as well as a pdf file containing their article(s).
