MOTION FOR CHANGE IN RULES OF IRISH MATHEMATICAL SOCIETY (Proposed by Committee)

RULE 1

Current

Every ordinary member shall pay, on election to membership and on the first day of October in each succeeding session an annual subscription to be determined by the Committee.

Proposed :

Every ordinary member shall pay, on application for membership and during the month of January in each succeeding session an annual subscription to be determined by the Committee. A change in the annual subscription shall be ratified by a meeting of the Society.

RULE 4

Current

The term of office shall be two years in the case of the President and Vice-President.

The President and Vice-President may not continue in office for two consecutive terms.

Proposed

The term of office of the office-bearers and of the Committee shall be two years.

RULE 5

Current

The additional members of the Committee shall be elected annually as shall the Treasurer and Secretary at the first ordinary meeting of each session.

Proposed :

On alternate years, elections for the following positions will take place

- (a) President, Vice-President and one half the additional members of the Committee;
- (b) Secretary, Treasurer and one half the additional members of the Committee.
