2. Matters arising

An IMS Mathematics Olympiad cup has been obtained for £200. Funds for Basic Research Grants have been allocated to the Department of Education instead of the Department of Industry, which may cause problems in the coming year. In the future there may be Research Councils set up within the H. E. A. to deal with Basic Research Grants and Postdoctoral Fellowships.

5. Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer presented the report for 1997. The surplus for the year ending 31 December 1997 was £730.03.
