## RECIPROCITY AGREEMENT

## IRISH MATHEMATICAL SOCIETY (IMS)

and

## REAL SOCIEDAD MATEMATICA ESPAÑOLA (RSME)

In accordance with all bylaws and regulations governing both Societies (article 10 of the IMS and articles 3.6, 9 d) and 23.5 of the RSME), and after consultation and approval of their respective governing bodies, the president of the IMS and the president of the RSME hereby sign this Reciprocity Agreement.

- 1.- The RSME recognizes to all members of the IMS in good standing, the right to become Reciprocity Members of the RSME. The annual membership fee will be equivalent to 50% of the annual fee charged to RSME members.
- 2.- The IMS recognize to all members of the RSME in good standing, the right to become Reciprocity Members of the IMS. The annual membership fee will be equivalent to 50% of the annual fee charged to IMS members.
- 3.- The reciprocity fee will be invoiced by each Society to its member together with its own annual membership fee. All reciprocal membership fees collected will be sent annually to the reciprocal Society.
- 4.- This option will be announced annually by each Society to all its members, clearly specifying the amount to pay after applying the previous percentages to the corresponding annual membership fee.
- 5.- Both societies agree to share all necessary data regarding reciprocity members so that to avoid problems of unpaid membership fees. To this effect a suitable mechanism will be implemented.
  - 6.- The IMS and the RSME agree:
  - To exchange periodical publications.
  - To exchange invitations for all relevant activities organized by each society.
- To keep frequent contacts aimed to the study and solving of problems associated with teaching and research in mathematics.
  - To organize a joint event.
- To carry out all necessary tasks to facilitate the exchange of researchers and graduate students between both countries.
- 7.- This present agreement will lose its validity by lack of fulfillment of its objectives or by simple request of one of the societies, as long as it has the approval of the appropriate governing bodies and be communicated early in advance.

This agreement is signed simultaneously by the Presidents of both Societies in the cities of Limerick (Ireland) and Madrid (Spain) on October 15, 2003.
