This will be a two day course covering the important aspects of Unix System Administration. The course will be given with the ICL DRS/6000 in mind, and will cover the following topics:

1. The functions of the Unix Administrator.
2. Fundamental Unix objects.
3. Useful tools for the Administrator.
4. Startup, Shutdown and rebooting.
5. Shell scripting.
6. Monitoring the system.
7. System security.
8. Disks, file systems and swap space.
9. Backup and restore.
10. Rebuilding Kernels.
11. The `sysadm` tool.

While example procedures will be given, the course also intends to provide a basic understanding of the system. This should allow the administrator to deal with new situations as they surface.
