Question 1. Construct a right-handed orthonormal basis X_1, X_2, X_3 where X_3 is in the direction $(1, -1, -1)$. Your answer should give the 3×3 matrix S whose columns are X_1, X_2, X_3 .

Question 2. Give the matrix A' for rotation through angle 60° around the z -axis, and calculate SA' where S is the matrix from Question 1.

Question 3. Hence or otherwise calculate the matrix for 60° rotation around the axis through $(1, -1, -1)$.

Question 4. Given the points $(-2, 0), (0, 3), (1, 2), (2, 3)$, we need their least-squared error linear estimator $y = mx + c$.

Reduce the problem to a system of equations in two unknowns:

$$A^T A \begin{bmatrix} m \\ c \end{bmatrix} = A^T Y$$

Question 5. Hence find the linear least-squared-error estimate.
