Question 1. Construct a right-handed orthonormal basis X_1, X_2, X_3 where X_3 is in the direction (1, -1, -1). Your answer should give the 3×3 matrix S whose columns are X_1, X_2, X_3 .

Question 2. Give the matrix A' for rotation through angle 60° around the z-axis, and calculate SA' where S is the matrix from Question 1.

Question 3. Hence or otherwise calculate the matrix for 60° rotation around the axis through (1,-1,-1).

Question 4. Given the points (-2,0), (0,3), (1,2), (2,3), we need their least-squared error linear estimator y = mx + c.

Reduce the problem to a system of equations in two unknowns:

$$A^T A \left[\begin{array}{c} m \\ c \end{array} \right] = A^T Y$$

Question 5. Hence find the linear least-squared-error estimate.
